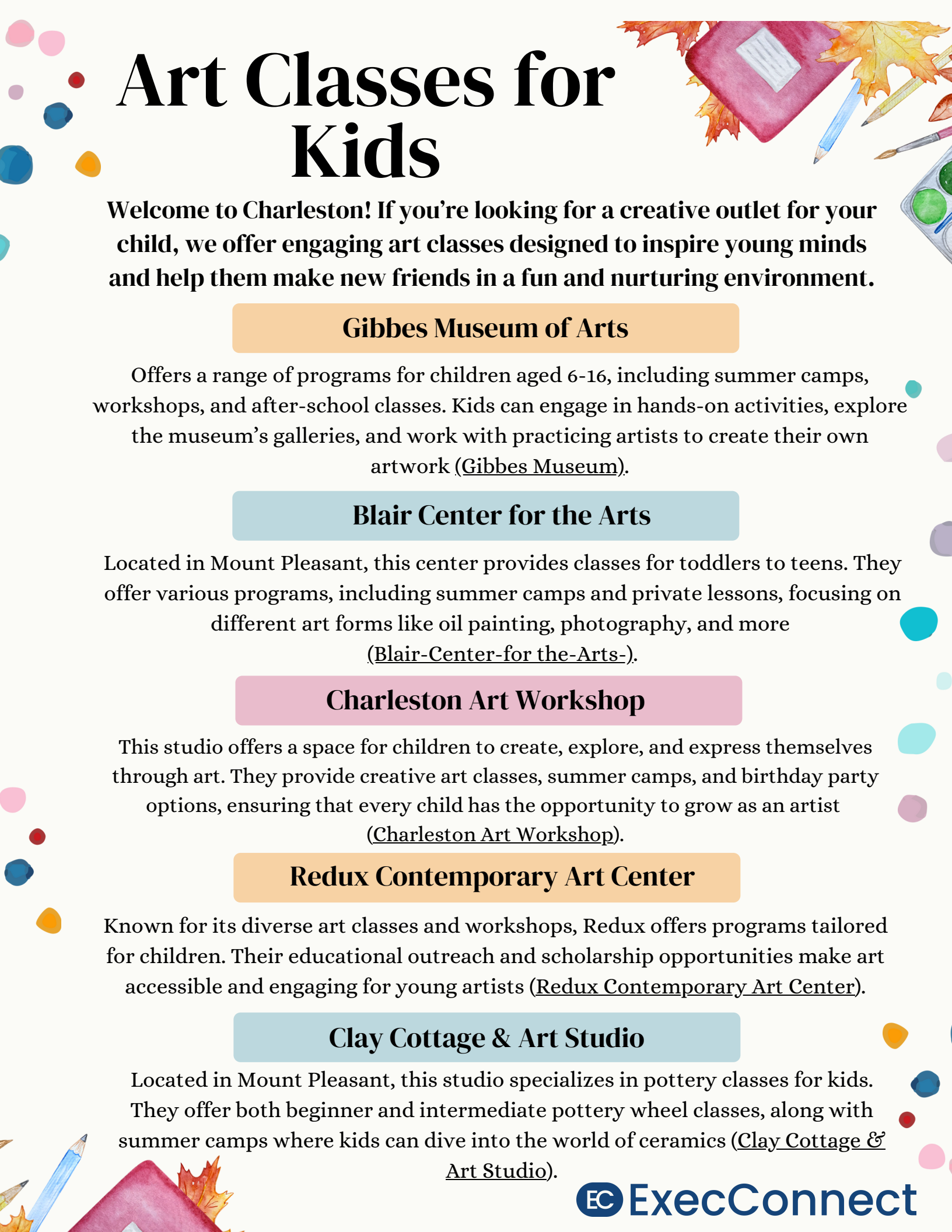




Art Classes for Kids
