Oceanside Collegiate Academy



- Oceanside Collegiate Academy (OCA) is a public charter high school located in Mount Pleasant, South Carolina, serving grades 9–12.

Charleston School of the Arts

- The school emphasizes excellence in both academics and artistic disciplines, boasting a 95% graduation rate.
- Its academic achievements include 87% reading proficiency and 77% math proficiency, outperforming state averages.
- SOA has a student-to-teacher ratio of 15:1 and a diverse student body, with 69% White, 14% Black, 8% Hispanic, 5% Asian, and 4% multiracial students.
- It provides a supportive and challenging environment for students with a passion for the arts while maintaining a strong focus on academic success.
