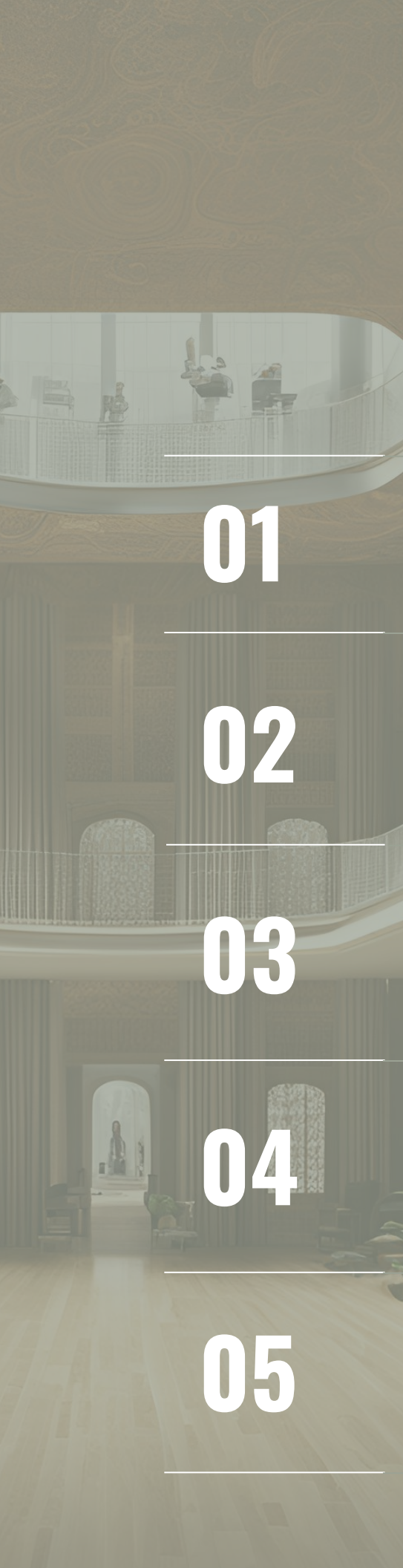

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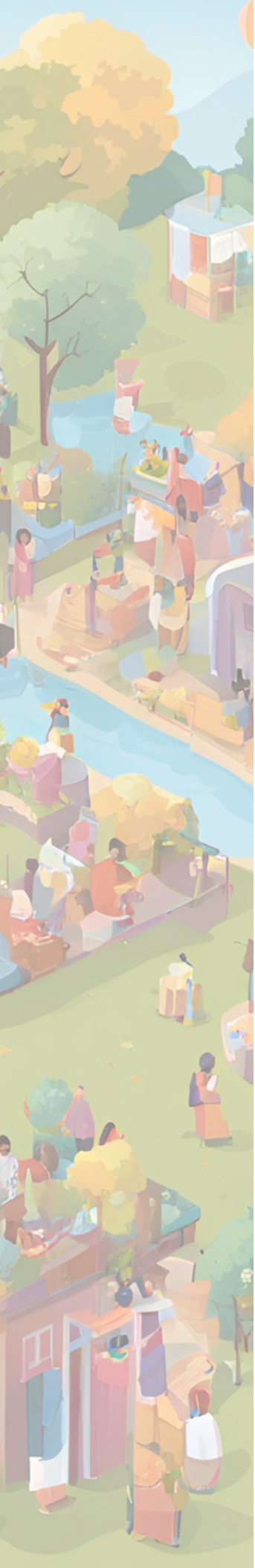

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# Cultural and Community Events

## *Cultural Celebrations and Festivals*

### **Black Expo Charleston**

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Known as the “Black Expo”, this one-day event has been held in Columbia, S.C. (eighteen years), Charleston, S.C. (sixteen years), Jacksonville, FL (fourteen years), Greenville, S.C. (four years) attracting over 800 exhibitors and 85,000 visitors.

### **Mojo Arts Festival**

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Celebrate the cultural contributions of the African American and the Caribbean American people through visual arts, music, poetry, gospel, storytelling and food.

### **Latin American Festival**

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Sponsored by Charleston County Park and Recreation Commission. The Latin American Festival celebrates the sights and sounds of the Latin world with live Salsa and Merengue music, authentic food and crafts, and plenty of activities for families to enjoy.

### **Lowcountry Nosh: Charleston Jewish Food & Heritage Festival**

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This festive event will feature a variety of traditional Jewish foods, including corned beef, chopped liver, “imported” bagels, knishes, rolled cabbage prepared by the Temple Sisterhood, and irresistible Jewish sweets. Activities for children, tours of KKBE’s historic property, and live entertainment will also be provided.

### **The Greater Charleston Lowcountry Jazz Festival**

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Experience award-winning jazz musicians at this annual event supporting Closing the Gap in Health Care, Inc., a nonprofit focused on reducing health disparities and promoting health literacy in underserved communities.

### **Charleston Greek Festival**

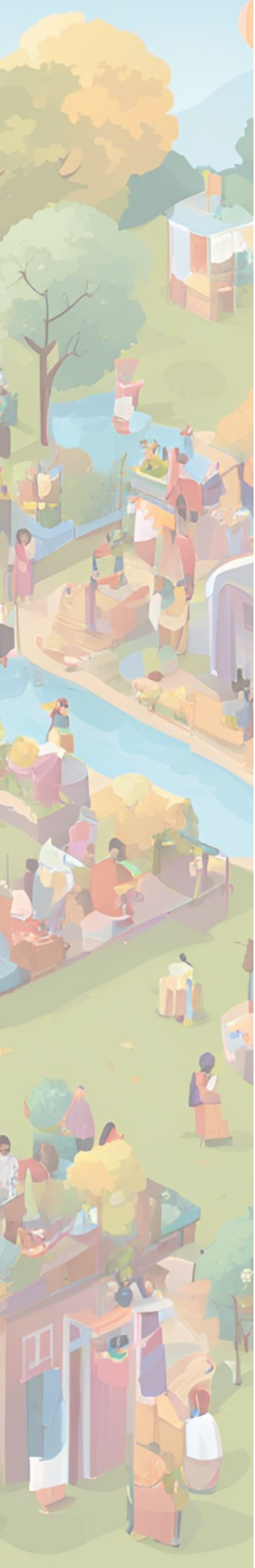
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Annual celebration of Greek culture, offering a vibrant experience filled with authentic food, music, dance, and cultural activities! Established in 1970, it has grown to become the third-largest festival in the Lowcountry, attracting over 35,000 visitors each year.

### **Spoletto USA**

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For 17 days and nights each spring, Spoleto Festival USA fills Charleston, South Carolina’s historic theaters, churches, and outdoor spaces with renowned artists as well as emerging performers in opera; theater; dance; and chamber, symphonic, choral, and jazz music.

## *Cultural Celebrations and Festivals*

### **Piccolo Spoleto Festival**

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Focusing primarily on artists of the Southeast region, Piccolo Spoleto is the perfect complement to the international scope of Spoleto Festival USA, its parent festival. Piccolo Spoleto's traditional program offerings include visual arts exhibits, classical music, jazz, dance, theatre, poetry readings, children's activities, choral music, ethnic cultural presentations, crafts, and film.

### **Southeastern Wildlife Exposition**

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The Southeastern Wildlife Exposition (SEWE) is a three-day celebration of wildlife and nature, featuring fine art, conservation education, sporting demos, food, and drink. Held in Charleston, SEWE is the largest event of its kind in the US, attracting over 40,000 attendees and showcasing hundreds of artists, exhibitors, and wildlife experts.

### **Lowcountry Oyster Festival**

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The Lowcountry Oyster Festival is the world's largest oyster festival. Highlights include the legendary "Oyster Shucking" and "Oyster Eating" Contests, live music on the main stage, wine, a selection of domestic and imported beers, a Children's Area, and a "Food Court" showcasing a variety of local favorite restaurants to satisfy everyone's taste.

### **Charleston Food & Wine Festival**

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Nearly 100 of the country's best wine and food purveyors can be found under the tents of Marion Square the first weekend in March during the BB&T Charleston Wine & Food Festival.

### **Charleston Asian American & Pacific Islander Collective**

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Community-driven organization dedicated to highlighting and celebrating Asian American culture, businesses, creatives, and heritage in Charleston. Their mission is to foster a deeper understanding and appreciation of AAPI communities through various events and initiative!

### **Reggae Nights Summer Concerts**

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Every summer, the Reggae Nights Summer Concert Series begins at James Island County Park featuring traditional old-school roots reggae with a new-school attitude in a beautiful outdoor setting.
