## **Redux Contemporary Art Center — Downtown Charleston**

A nonprofit contemporary arts center offering professional studio space for emerging to mid-career artists with 24/7 access, darkroom & print facilities, exhibitions, critiques, visiting artist talks, and open studios. Redux supports artist career development, exhibitions, and community connection.

## **Shine Studio – Downtown Charleston**

A professional photography and creative production studio offering bright natural light space for photo shoots, video production, and brand content creation. Available for hourly or daily rental, ideal for photographers and creative professionals needing a flexible studio environment.

## **Charleston Artist Guild — Downtown Charleston**

A long-standing artist nonprofit and member organization with more than 600 members. CAG hosts exhibitions, membership opportunities, juried shows, workshops, critiques, and gallery representation for artists at varying career levels. Artists can exhibit in the CAG Gallery and connect with collectors and peers.

## **Noble Studios — North Charleston Navy Yard**

A large multi-use production and photography studio with high ceilings, cyc wall, lighting grid, and ample workspace suitable for professional photo shoots, art production, film/video, and set work. While more commercial in nature, it's used by local creatives and connects into the professional artist scene through events and exhibitions.

## **Studio Union — North Charleston**

A professional artist studio collective that provides long-term workspace for painters, sculptors, ceramicists, photographers, and more. The space fosters community, shared creativity, events and exhibitions. Artists here engage with peers and the broader Charleston art ecosystem.
